- ➤ Grade 12 students must request a minimum of 30 credits. *If the total credits earned by the end of grade 11 is projected to be less than 75, you MUST choose 35 credits minimum (14 Scheduling Blocks).
- A full timetable consists of 16 SCHEDULING BLOCKS. Grade 12's may choose 12-16 SCHEDULING BLOCKS.
 - 3-credit courses count as one (1) scheduling block; 5-credit courses count as two (2) scheduling blocks & 10-credit courses count as four (4) scheduling blocks
- Instrumental Music & Musical Theatre are outside the timetable but do count as 2 scheduling blocks each.
